To all Doxpop users:

As we wrote to you previously, on December 17, 2007, Monroe County courts ceased transmitting updates to Doxpop. Since that time we have supplied access to static, historical records. The current regulatory approval to publish these records expires on February 15, 2008, and the Monroe County Courts have indicated that they do not intend to renew that approval. So, effective the evening of February 15, information from Monroe County will not be available on Doxpop in any form.

Monroe County is important to Doxpop and our users. We continue to seek the cooperation of the Division of State Court Administration and Judicial Technology and Automation Committee (JTAC) in restoring Doxpop service for Monroe County. On October 25, 2007, over 3 months ago, we submitted the proper administrative request and are currently awaiting action by the Division. The Division has indicated that the matter is pending before the Indiana Supreme Court.

In the meantime, Doxpop continues to expand our coverage to other Indiana counties. The most recent addition, LaPorte County, pushes our list of current partners up to 43 counties and 4 municipalities. We anticipate several other major announcements in the near future as well as the return of Monroe County when the Division is able to act on our pending request.
